LOTTO SPONSORSHIP - IMPORTANT NOTE:

The instructor of each club can apply to AFSA for a maximum of 2 people from that club to attend the seminar at a reduced seminar fee of **R250,00 per member**. That member must be a paid-up AFSA member for 2008. A written motivation must be faxed to the AFSA secretary at (011) 744 3568 **before 12:00 on 02/06/2008** on behalf of such a member. The Executive Committee shall consider such application and their decision shall be final.

NO GRADING REGISTRATION WILL BE ALLOWED DURING THE SEMINAR. Grading registration forms, signed by yourself and endorsed by your club instructor, must reach the AFSA Secretary on or before **12:00 on 15/06/2008** (faxed to (011) 744 3568), otherwise grading at the AFSA Winterschool 2008 will not be permitted. The successful applicants' name will thereafter be publicised. The applicable grading fee must then be submitted along with your AFSA card (with a **passport photo** of yourself) to the AFSA Secretary at grading registration on **Thursay 03/07/2008** at 08:00 during grading registration.

Hombu grading payment. Applicant's applying for Dan grading must also pay a deposit in cash to the AFSA Secretary to cover their fees payable to Hombu before taking the examination. These are: Shodan = R800,00, Nidan = R1 000,00, Sandan = R1 500,00, Yondan = R2 000,00

AFSA ARRANGED ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS
